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### Early Years Pupil Premium

Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP) is additional funding that is allocated to nurseries to support children from low-income families. This includes families of Looked After Children, families who are eligible for Free School Meals (FSM) and children from service families.

The allocation for 2018-19 is £302.10 per child and 10 children are in receipt of this funding.

For children who have additional needs who are also EYPP. (7 children) The funding is being used to contribute to SEND staff training and targeted 1:1 support.

For all children in receipt of EYPP, we have invested in staff training. This includes on going training regarding our system of 'child initiated learning', helping staff to find the teachable moment and use this to bring each child's learning forward in an individualised way.

We are also developing the staff's understanding of the Leuven Scales of well-being and involvement through ongoing training and this continues to have a very positive impact on pupil premium children as most have low PSED on entry.

We have also invested in joining the South London Teaching school alliance. As part of our participation with them, we are involved in a research project about autism. This is contributing to staff's understanding of all autism spectrum disorders. This involves looking at how we can develop our environment to make it more accessible to children with different levels of need.
